Refund Policy 2024_25

Refunds will only be considered where exceptional circumstances exist.

The following are the criteria for consideration of exceptional circumstances.

- Before October 31
 - the athlete suffers an accident or illness that prevents them from competing for the rest of the season, or
 - the athlete's family suffer some circumstance that makes it clear the athlete will not be able to compete for the rest of the season , or
 - the athlete moves away from the region, or
 - there has been an incident at competition that leads the athlete to be unable to compete for the rest of the season
- It is proven that the centre has given incorrect advice to the athlete and their family.

After October these circumstances will not enable a refund, however we would facilitate your transfer to another club.

Please Note that an athlete changing their mind about competing is not considered exceptional circumstances.

The following will be the refund amounts that apply should there be exceptional circumstances and we have agreed to offer a refund

- Any unused uniforms returned will be refunded in full
- Any used uniforms returned will be refunded at 80% of purchase price provided they are returned clean and in a resaleable condition
- Parent levies will be refunded in full
- The centre part of registration fees only can be refunded and as we are required to pay the Queensland Little Athletics Association for the registration regardless.
 - For 2024_25 the Centre part of the registration fees which are refundable:
 - Tiny Tots \$18.00
 - U6 to U17 \$63.00
 - The total amount of registration fees refunded may not exceed the family cap less association fees paid
- Track Access levies are not refundable

If the request is received later than 31 October, then there is no refund of fees available
